- Private company owned by EOS/People Plus
- Contracted by MOJ to deliver rehabilitation services across Warwickshire and West Mercia
- Low and medium risk offenders on community orders, in prison and on release
- Interventions – unpaid work, accredited programmes, rehabilitation activities for CRC and NPS

History

- June 2014 - CRC created from Probation Trusts
- Feb 2015 – new owners – EOS
- Feb 2015 – new legislation for Through the Gate and rehabilitation
- May 2015 – HMIP Hewell and Featherstone
 - CRC staff in prisons
 - Meet and Mentor
 - Self Awareness and Relationship Management
